## SUBJECT: UNIVERSAL MOUNTING BRACKET

Due to a change in the method of mounting a KM unit to a Hoshizaki bin, a new mounting bracket has been designed.

Newer bins have a slot which the new bracket hooks into and older bins have a screw hole to secure the bracket with a M5X12 stainless bolt. If you are installing a KM unit onto a new style Hoshizaki bin and angle mounting brackets were supplied in the accessory bag, you have 2 choices. You can use the angle brackets supplied by securing the bracket to the bin with a number 10 x 1/2" sheet metal screw or you can order 2 new Hoshizaki brackets, part number 4A0363-01, universal brackets which will fit either application. The unit must be secured to the bin regardless of which bracket is used.

While we realize this is an inconvenience, as inventory rolls over, this concern will work itself out.

Below is a drawing of the universal bracket.

- A. Use hole 1 and hook 4 if the bin has slots.
- B. Use holes 1 and 3 for KM-250M if the bin has threaded holes.
- C. Use holes 1 and 2 or 2 and 3 on all other models if the bin has threaded holes.
